Established in 2014, Jessup Theatre is an award-winning department serving an average of

2,000 patrons for plays and 4,500 patrons for musicals over the course of 2 weekends.

Responsibilities include:

- o Creative: assisting director with casting, marketing art direction and implementation, notation of show while in creation and actor coaching
- o Management: box office, sales, community liaisons, front of house staff, supporting design team, and training and mobilizing approximately 30 student volunteers working with design and creative team
- Sustainability: meeting ticket sales goal/donations goal which is the full amount of the cost of the shows
- o Environment: transform a warehouse into a theatre which includes creating dressing room and wardrobe spaces, managing paint and lab space, numbering and lettering all seats according to box office seating chart the day of the show, creating a safe flow of traffic with appropriate signage, and training volunteer staff
- o Design and implement a pre-show experience for each production. This is a fully realized experiential environment where patrons can enter the world of the show one hour before curtain and during intermission. Pre-Show includes a designed space, performance element, activities, and food and beverage. For holiday productions, it also includes 2 shops where people can holiday shop before and during the show. Past shops have included the Christmas shop, Miss Potts tea shop, and Bell's Tiara shop. We work with 2 outside venders to provide warm cinnamon rolls and hot chocolate or hot apple cider for our patrons.
- o Work with development, student workers, events, creative staff, upper administration, marketing and media services to ensure good PR and reputation among and on behalf of the university o "Bethlehem" was produced during COVID (November 2020) as a professionally produced film and delivered with limited seating to faculty, staff, and students. For outside guests, they could access the full-length original musical on a streaming platform and as a drive-in movie with live dancing elements. A small crew turned a parking lot on campus into a drive-in lot, the movie was played on a large elevated LED screen, and the audio could be accessed by tuning into a local radio station.
